He had no Certificate, only a Discharge from Coll. Belt (whose Servant he had been) and a Duplicate of his Indenture. He had a young black Stalion. Whoever secures the said Thomas Smith, to Mr. Denune aforesaid, or to Mr. Annon, Master of the Grammar School, in Philadelphia, shall have Two Pistoles Reward, over and above the Allowance by Law.
