

Sir Arthur de Denune, lived during the reign of Alexander III, was a witness in 1294, compelled to submit to Edward I in 1296

Guy de Denune

They were the forbears of most Denunes in Scotland

Duncan Campbell, the governor of Denune Castle, whose mother was a Denune, now Duncan Denune

Duncan was sentenced to be drowned in the Clyde River for committing several depredations and driving the Argyle cattle into his cattle. He and his brother Donald fled into the western highlands and assumed their mother's maiden name, Denune

Donald Campbell, now Donald Denune, became abbot of Ferne in Rossshire, where he acquired considerable wealth.

Andrew Denune, acquired his uncle Donald the abbot's lands and barony of Catbole in Rossshire 1534

John Denune of Catbole, who married Catharine Ross, daughter of the ancient family of Blamagowan

John Denune, the third baron of Catbole, who never married and resigned his land in favor of his brother Andrew, died without issue before the year 1604

Andrew Denune, fourth baron of Catbole, received the hereditary barony from his grandfather Andrew, the penult day of September 1604, got another charter of lands of Milntoun of Fern September 1594, also a charter at his brother's resignation on March 12<sup>th</sup>, 1589, confirmation June 11<sup>th</sup>, 1611, who died before the year 1620

John Denune, fifth baron of Catbole, loyal subject of Charles I, spent his fortune in his service, died before any redress by Charles II

Norman Denune Esq., inherited his father's virtues, but none of his estate, married Catharine Munro, daughter of Hector Munro of Foutis Bart

Mr. William Denune, born 1656, a man of parts and learning, bred to the church, minister at Pencaitland in east Lothian, married 1688 Isabella, daughter of Doctor George Hepburn of Moncraig, husband of Helen Swinton, daughter of Alexander Swinton, Mr. William Denune died Jan. 1704

Walter Denune Esq., settled in the East Indies

George Denune Esq., his will confirmed 4 July 1729, married Isabella, daughter of Alexander Edgar younger of Wedderley Esq.

Christian, baptized May 10, 1697 married to James Hepburn Congalton Esq. of east Lothian, no issue
